The Brazilian Longitudinal Study of Ageing - Biomarker Update



Past

- Two waves of data collection:
 2015-2016; 2019-2021 with
 replacement of the sample
 (~9,500 in each wave)
 - Physical measures: blood pressure, anthropometry, gait speed, grip strength and balance (2015-2016; 2019-2021)
 - Venous blood in a subsample (~2,500) (2015-2016)

Present

- Currently collecting:
 - Physical measures: every 3 to 4 years
 - Venous blood: no plans to collect
- What assays are you measuring?
 - DNA: Population ancestry

Future

- In the field by middle (2022-3)
- Plans to collect physical measures every 3 to 4 years
- Venous blood: will not be collected in 3rd wave
- New measures:
 - DNA, serum and plasma samples are stored for future analysis




Figure 1 The flow of respondents through the Brazilian Longitudinal Study of Ageing (ELSI-Brazil)
